Background Information

Outreachy internships were inspired in many ways by Google Summer of Code and by how few women applied for it in the past. This was reflective of a generally low number of women participating in the FOSS development.

The GNOME Foundation first started the internships program with one round in 2006, and then resumed the effort in 2010 with rounds organized twice a year.

 322 participants since 2010

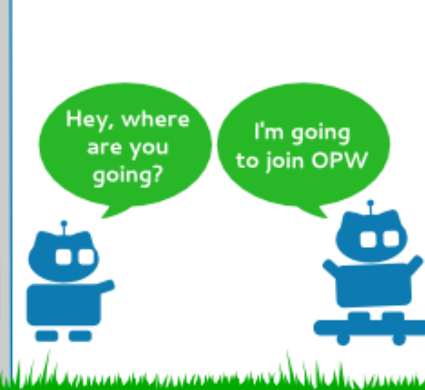
 41 participants with 12 organizations this summer



Program details

-  The next round of Outreachy internships will have an application deadline on October 17, 2016, and internship dates from December 6, 2016 to March 6, 2017
-  The organizations that will participate in the next round will be announced on September 5.
-  Not limited to coding, but include user experience design, graphic design, documentation, web development, marketing, translation and other types of tasks needed to sustain a FOSS project.
-  The accepted participants work remotely, while being guided by their mentor.
-  Participants will be expected to blog at least once every two weeks about their work.
-  The accepted participants will receive \$5,500 stipend.
